## **PREAMBLE**

This five-day workshop is envisioned as an exploration of different topics under the highly relevant concept of building and sustaining people-centric built environments through creative design ideas. Each day of the workshop has a different theme / topic related to urban habitats and communities in India. In the first half of each day, RVCA faculty and other invited speakers will present talks and lead discussions with participants. In the second half, invited experts will conduct workshops with Bengaluru as a laboratory for exploring the theme of that day.

#### SIGNIFICANCE AND OBJECTIVES

This workshop aims to acquaint participants with the methods and approaches that involve and seek inputs from communities in shaping their built environments. The five-day event encourages participants to conceptualize and engage with urbanism from a "lived" or people-centric perspective.

## THEMES

### Day 1: Social inclusivity

(gender-sensitivity, safe and imaginative design for diverse social groups, mobility and safe access, living heritage)

#### Day 2: Community and urbanism

(urban commons, grounded research methods, urban imagery)

# Day 3: Sustainable materials and participatory practices

(building with sustainable materials, biomimicry, participatory design)

#### Day 4: Green infrastructure

(biomimicry, communities and urban commons, sustainable development)

Day 5: Writing workshop on Indian urbanism
