PhD: Synthesis of Culture and Urban Planning for sustainability of pilgrimage places.

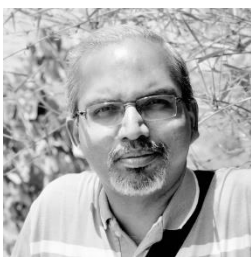
Contribution: Constructed a Praxis adaptive framework for planning of pilgrimage towns, and sustainability.
