Preamble

The "Roof Over Our Heads" faculty training program is planned in collaboration with the Society for the Promotion of Area Resource Centres (SPARC) which is one of the larger NGOs in India focused on working in informal settlements. Implementing the ROOH program is crucial to equip teachers with the knowledge and tools needed to address climate-related challenges faced by informal communities. By integrating this campaign into the curriculum, educators/academicians can impart essential insights and practical strategies to future budding architects. This initiative goes beyond theoretical learning by providing a deep understanding of real-life vulnerabilities experienced by these communities due to climate hazards. It empowers teachers to comprehend and appreciate the adaptive measures these communities employ to cope with and mitigate environmental risks.



Key take-aways for participants.

- The participants will learn to work in collaboration with informal settlement communities as populations who seek professional/ scientific knowledge to better living conditions.
- They will understand the impact of extreme weather conditions due to climate change on informal settlements across all the climatic zones.
- They will be able to document and analyze the way in which communities are using adaptive strategies and coping mechanisms to extreme weather conditions.
- Learn to assess the performance of building materials, construction techniques and document any local innovative practices, and suggest improvisations to improvise with scientific knowledge that can be scaled up.
- Upon completion of the training, the participating teachers will be equipped to integrate the objectives of the campaign for Roof Over Our Heads (ROOH) into the curriculum of their respective colleges by designing studio projects.

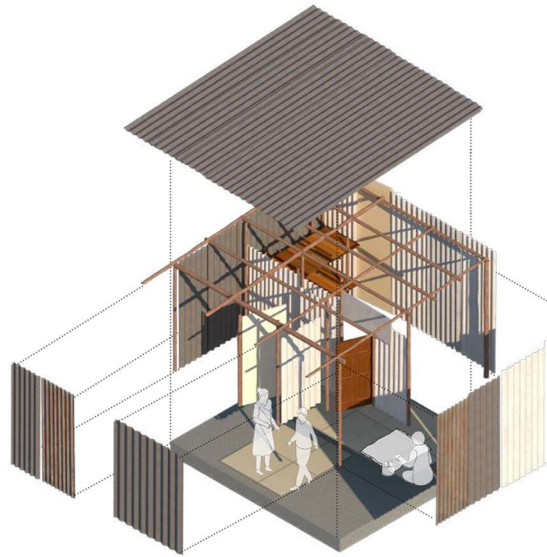
