



Five Days Online Faculty Development Program on

TEACHING AND APPLYING ARCHITECTURE THROUGH HUMANITIES

In the painting called "Pericles' Funeral Oration (*Perikles hält die Leichenrede*)" by Philipp Foltz; sketches the scene of Pericles' oration over the Funeral Pyre of Athenians at the lost Peloponnesian war.

In the Oration; Pericles' says:

"Our political system does not compete with institutions which are elsewhere in force. We do not copy our neighbors, but try to be an example. Our administration favors the many instead of the few: this is why it is called a democracy."

In the background of the painting is the Acropolis of Athens; on which sits the unmistakable Parthenon. Pericles' gesture also prompts an idea of provocation while pointing the great Parthenon. The narration enlivens Architecture. The oration and the architecture in the painting reflects the democracy of Greek Civilization. Hence we bring Humanities, Politics, Art, literature and Architecture into one narrative. For all those who thought that Humanities was the most boring and theoretical subject to learn or teach; there is a new perspective on board. Through this process not only can one weave a student's interest into the subject but also make them aware of the other subjects of Architecture and interdisciplinary connects.
