
# Intelligent Tools, Intuitive Designers: Al's role in Architectural Education

While AI offers powerful computational capabilities, the architect's role remains grounded in intuition, empathy, and contextual insight. AI complements—not replaces—human design thinking.

The aim is to develop architects who are not only tech-savvy but also ethically grounded and culturally responsive.
