

## **NOTICE FOR INSTITUTIONS**

Sub : Quota for the wards of Kashmiri migrants for admission to 1<sup>st</sup> year of 5-year B.Arch. Degree course

It is hereby informed that based on letters No. D.O. No.F.1-13/2010 (CPP-II) dated 23<sup>rd</sup> March, 2015 and D.O. No.F.1-1/2012 (SA-III) dated 10<sup>th</sup> March, 2015 from University Grants Commission, New Delhi, it has been decided by the competent authority of the Council of Architecture to allow all institutions imparting 5-year B.Arch. degree course in the country to create supernumerary seats over and above the sanctioned intake, specifically for **students belonging to Jammu & Kashmir** (i.e. J&K quota) for admission to 1<sup>st</sup> year of the said course for 2015-2016, **upto 5% of intake sanctioned by the Council** in 5-year B.Arch. degree course.

These supernumerary seats are to be filled up only by students belonging to Jammu & Kashmir, possessing valid domicile and/or other documentary evidence. In the event of non-availability of any student from Jammu & Kashmir, these seats must remain vacant. Further, all students admitted under this quota must fulfill the eligibility criteria as prescribed by the Council for admission to 1<sup>st</sup> year of 5-year B.Arch. degree course and also must have passed an Aptitude Test in Architecture prior to admission.
