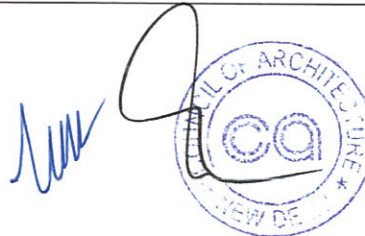

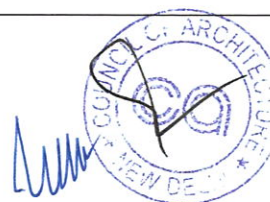

Accordingly, the Committee has prepared the Draft Approval Process Handbook.</p> <p>The Executive Committee perused the Approval Process Handbook along with inputs of the COA office and after deliberations approved the same and decided that the same be placed before the Council for according its approval.</p>

	<p>The Chairman informed the members that in order to effectively implement the Council of Architecture (Minimum Standards of Architectural Education) Regulations, 2020 they require certain amendments.</p> <p>The Chairman further apprised the members that the proposed amendments were originally part of the Council's proposal of Draft Minimum Standards of Architectural Education Regulations, 2017 but were not included in the Regulations of 2020.</p> <p>The Executive Committee perused the proposed amendments in the Council of Architecture (Minimum Standards of Architectural Education) Regulations, 2020 and after deliberations approved the same and decided that these amendments be placed before Council for according its approval.</p>

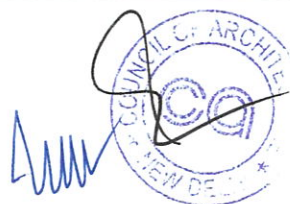

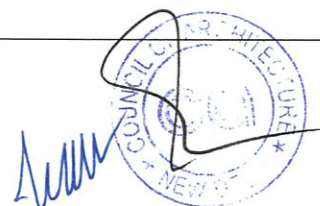

Gyanendra Singh, Special Invitee, keeping in view that there are several foreign architectural qualifications recognised under the Architects Act since the enactment of the Act in the year 1972 but the Council is not aware whether such qualifications are still valid or not; and also whether they are 4 year or 5 year course (integrated Masters/ Ph.D course).</p> <p>The Committee was mandated to examine the qualifications presently notified under the Act for the purpose of registration as an architect with the Council and to make appropriate recommendations about the status of these qualifications.</p> <p>The Committee was also mandated to bifurcate these qualifications into UG, PG and Ph.D. Level. Undergraduate level will be basic qualification for registration and other higher qualifications will be additional qualifications for recruitment in Architectural Institutions and in Govt. Service, etc. The Committee after examining the matter has submitted its report to the Council.</p> <p>The Executive Committee perused the report of the Sub-Committee and the draft Regulations as suggested by the Committee and agreed in principle with the recommendations of the Committee.
