ITEM NO.4 TO TAKE NOTE OF THE STATUS OF NATA 2018 EXAMINATION.

The Chairman informed the Members that the first NATA 2019 Test was conducted on 14.04.2019 at 191 Centres all over India and also at one Centre at Dubai. 35,748 candidates registered for that test and 32761 candidates appeared for the test. Further, the Members were informed that the evaluation of drawing papers is under way at two Centres one at Noida and another at Bengaluru.

The Chairman informed the Members that the result will be announced on 03.05.2019. The Executive Committee appreciated the efforts made in the conduct of examination.

ITEM NO.5 ANY OTHER ITEM WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR.

I) TO CONSIDER APPLICATIONS SUBMITTED BY THE INSTITUTIOS FOR EXTENSION OF APPROVAL FOR B.ARCH DEGREE COURSE FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2019-2010 WHICH HAVE NOT YET BEEN INSPECTED BY THE COUNCIL.

The Chairman informed the Members that the Council has conducted inspection of various institutions which have applied for extension of approval of B.Arch/M.Arch course, however, there are about 230 institutions which are yet to be inspected by the Council. Due to paucity of time it may not be possible to inspect these institutions.

Further, the academic calendar of the Council also mandates that the approval of these institutions be communicated to the concerned institutions by 15.05.2019.

Therefore, it was decided to scrutinize the applications of the concerned institutions and accordingly a detailed statement of faculty position of all the institutions was prepared for consideration and decision by the Executive Committee.

The Executive Committee perused the Applications and Scrutiny Sheet of the institutions and after detailed deliberations decided that intake/and period of approval of concerned institutions as per **Appendix-E** attached herewith.
