ABOUT THE FDP

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Ar. Rajeev Kathpalia is a partner at Vastu Shilpa Consultants, or VSC, the multi-disciplinary practice founded in 1955 by the Pritzker Laureate Balkrishna Doshi. Renowned for his institutional designs, he has won several national and international competitions. His net zero approach to campus design, which integrates architecture, landscape, ecology, energy generation and management has set new benchmarks for sustainability and innovation.



Ar. Sanjay Kanvinde, an architect and urban designer, is a senior partner with Kanvinde Rai Chowdhury. He has been associated with the design and execution of various educational institutions. The current assignments being handled include a Research Lab complex at IIT Kanpur, a Research park at IIT Gandhinagar and the recently awarded IIT Bhubaneswar project.

Ar. Gayathri Shetty is a partner of Gayathri Namith Architects, Bengaluru, which has more than 70 professionals belonging to architecture, art, product design, sculpture, lighting design and graphic design. GNA has been recognised with 27 national awards for a variety of projects including campus design. Among the numerous awards is the JK Architect of the year commendation Award for Recycling of Architectural Heritage 1995.



Ar. Madhav Joshi established his own design studio, Madhav Joshi and Associates in 1998. The studio's projects explore new frontiers of contextual modernism, firmly rooted in the Indian context. Among a variety of projects handed by the studio, are institutional campuses. A noted institutional work by the studio is the Heritage Residential School at Talegaon. Ar. Joshi has won many national and International awards, one of which is the JK Cement Green Architecture International Award 2010.

Ar. Latha Raman Jaigopal is a co-founder and Head of projects of Inspiration - a multi disciplinary collective based in Kochi. With a passion for responsible and holistic approach to architecture, Latha guides the design interpretation, project management and technical teams of Inspiration, besides playing a key role in concepts of total water management and relevant renewable energy applications,



Ar. Mehul Patel is an architect with more than two decades of experience, who has worked on projects of various typologies, including campus projects. Mehul has been practising and mentoring architecture as a principal at CnT architects, Bengaluru, since 2005. His focus has been on architecture which is pragmatic and sustainable and reflects the ethos of time, place and context. He has won several design competitions and awards, notably the 20th JK Cement Architect of the year Award in 2010 for the Tata - Dhan Academy, Madurai.

Prof. Kishor Rewatkar has been an academician and a practitioner of architecture since last four decades. Presently, he is Professor and Dean research at Priyadarshini Institute of Architecture and Design studies, Nagpur. He concurrently runs his practice. He has designed Institutional campuses and administrative buildings. He was selected as the architect for the new campus of Manipal Institute of Technology and for the Campus for Board of Higher Secondary Education at Latur, Maharashtra.



Ar. Daraius Choksi has been associated with CCBA Design, Pune, since 1999 and is currently Architecture Director of CCBA. He has worked on educational projects and is involved from design development stage to construction and post-occupation interaction and handing over. He was selected among the top 50 next generation Architects by Architect & Interiors Magazine, i GEN Design Forum 2015.

Ar. Aparna Narasimhan, an architect with over three decades of experience, is a partner and Design Director at Venkataramanan Associates, Bengaluru. Her work in institutional projects is characterised by abilities which range from master-plan level decision making to minute design detailing. She is the winner of several awards including the Architect of the year Award, 2012 by JK Cement for Art village - The Valley School Bengaluru.
