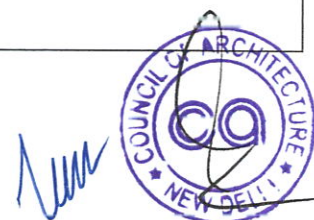

	<p>The Chairman informed the members that the inspectors appointed by the Council have inspected the concerned institutions for imparting B.Arch./ M.Arch. Course(s) for the academic session 2021–2022 and submitted their report to the Council. The inspection reports have been assessed by the Scrutiny Committee to assist the Executive Committee in arriving at its decision.</p> <p>The Executive Committee perused list of institutions along with inspection reports & report of Scrutiny Committee and after deliberations made its decision in respect of the concerned institutions. I)	TO CONSIDER THE LETTER DATED 02.08.2021, RECEIVED FROM VICE-CHANCELLOR, DR. APJ ABDUL KALAM TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY, LUCKNOW, UTTAR PRADESH.
	<p>The Chairman informed the members that the office of the Council is in receipt of letter dated 02.08.2021 from the Vice-Chancellor, Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Technical University, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh, requesting the Council to relax the mandatory requirement of passing the NATA 2021 Examination for admission to B.Arch. Course for the academic session 2021-22. He has also assured the Council that from the academic session 2022-2023, the University shall ensure that admissions are made in the B.Arch. course as per the directions of the Council.</p> <p>The Executive Committee noted that the Council of Architecture Minimum Standards Regulations 2020 were notified in August 2020 and are in force since 01.11.2020 and University should have complied with the Regulations of the Council. The NATA is being followed all over India to avoid multiplicity of Tests. Allowing a particular State/University at this advance stage when admissions are being conducted, to not to follow the requirement of NATA would be contrary to the Regulations.</p>
